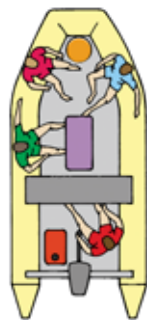


CATARACT CANYON

One Day Expedition Cataract Canyon



Never before has a one-day run through Cataract Canyon been available. Traveling in state-of-the-art Whitewater RHIBs (Rigid Inflatable Boat), we will cruise at 24 m.p.h. on the flat water and Lake Powell, giving

us the ability to travel this famous 100 mile section of the Colorado river in only one day. In the rapids the RHIB is unsurpassed in fun and stability. Our trips leave the NAVTEC office at 7:00 AM (Mountain Daylight Time). We'll shuttle by van to our put-in at the Potash boat ramp, and be on the river and underway by 8:00 AM. Your one day "Cat trip" will take you under Dead Horse Point and into the heart of Canyonlands National Park. The first 50 miles is calm, lazy water with stunning canyon vistas in an outstanding wilderness setting. Photographic opportunities abound. With any luck you may see a herd of desert big horn sheep or mule deer browsing near the river's edge. Sightings of eagles soaring overhead and great blue heron feeding along the shore are not infrequent.



At noon, a buffet-style picnic lunch will be served on the banks of the river, with time afterwards for swimming, or relaxing in the shade. Back on the river, we pass the confluence where the mighty Green and Colorado Rivers merge. Just past the Doll House are the rapids of Cataract Canyon. Our RHIBs provide a superb ride as we pass through one wave after the other. Small and maneuverable, the Whitewater RHIB is the most dynamic craft on the river. We'll run rapids with names like Hell-to-Pay, Capsize, and the famous Big Drops. Cataract has some of the finest whitewater in the United States during the spring run-off in May and June. Late summer offers smaller, but still thrilling rapids.

A short break after hitting the upper waters of Lake Powell will allow us time to reflect on the beauty and excitement of the day. A thirty-mile run across the lake will bring us to Hite Marina, Utah and the end of our trip at about

6:00 PM (time can vary.) Undoubtedly, one of the most exciting one-day river trips in the United States.

When making your reservation, select one of the return transportation options below. Public transportation is not available at Hite. NAVTEC Ground transportation takes about 4 hrs. and arrives back in Moab around 10:00 PM. We usually stop in Hanksville for dinner (*your expense*.) The most popular option is the scenic charter flight over Cataract Canyon and Canyonlands National Park back to Moab. This option has you back in Moab about 7:45 PM, with time for a shower and dinner. Families and groups can save by having their car shuttled to Hite.

2010 Tour Cost : Adult \$375 / Youth \$325 (16 & younger) per person plus transportation from Hite. Choose one of the transportation options below and add to the cost of your trip.

- 1) Fly from Hite to Moab w/ ride to town (1.5 hr trip time, 45 min flight time):\$120/person + tax
- 2) Have your vehicle shuttled to Hite at the end of the trip:.....\$250/vehicle + tax
- 3) Ground transportation from Hite to Moab (4 hr drive):\$35/person + tax

Booking: We require a \$100/person deposit to hold reservations. Final payment is due 30 days prior to trip departure. Deposits are refundable less a \$50/person service charge if NAVTEC receives notification at least 30 days prior to departure. Final payment due 30 days before departure. Sorry, no refund will be made if cancellation is within 30 days of departure.

Included: 1) the river trip as described, by state-of-the-art Whitewater RHIB; 2) a quality buffet style lunch; 3) Coast Guard approved life jackets, river bags and camera box; 4) ground transportation from our office to the river put-in; 5) licensed experienced guide service

Not Included: 1) soda pop (bring your own and we provide the ice and cooler). 2) Return transportation from Hite Marina. 3) gratuities to guides.
